Introduction: circumstances, conversation, context

- I. One must be born again to enter the kingdom of God.
- II. What it means to be born again
 - A. The term itself: “born again” (v. 3)
 - B. Water and Spirit (v. 5,6; Eze. 36:25,26)
 - C. Spirit (v. 8; John 1:12,13)
 - D. Leads to faith, believing in Jesus Christ (v. 13-15)
 1. As the Son of God from heaven (v. 13)
 2. As the provision of God (v. 14,15)
- III. Necessity of being born again to see and to enter the Kingdom of God (v. 7,10,12)
- IV. Being born again rejected by many (v. 11)
- V. Being born again will be enjoyed by many (v. 16)
